installation her practice explores the physicality and the politics of the female voice. Performing using her own voice, she interweaves historical, fictional and autobiographical narratives in the construction of new scripted scores. During the residency at Draíocht, McDonnell will be developing and composing a new sound installation alongside a live performance and photographic series.
