



Draíocht's Artist-in-Residence Daniel Shaw-Smith will be available to meet your class group enabling your pupils to view and discuss the work of painter Mark McGreevy, as well as his own sculpture and painting. The 30 minute tour will include comparing and contrasting the two artist's work, talking to Daniel about life as an artist, where he gets his inspiration from and visiting the Draíocht artist's studio.

Mark McGreevy

Mark McGreevy's exhibition is comprised of large scale semi-abstract paintings, in vivid hues of pink, orange, yellow and blue. They feature references and mini-narratives from popular culture, borrowing from science fiction, simulated computer cities, fantasy toys, real and imaginary architecture, films and journalism.

Daniel Shaw-Smith

Currently Draíocht's Artist-in-Residence, Daniel works as a painter and sculptor. Visit Daniel's Studio and see his 'Gone to the Dogs' sculpture, a piece made up of life size dogs in different poses. His paintings will also be on show through a slide show. These depict very strange goings-on in very ordinary settings and can combine humour, tragedy and horror all at once.
